## Artist of the Month

Maurits Cornelis Escher

ART FORM: POP ART & SURREALISM

INTERESTING FACTS

1. Escher did so poorly in school that he even failed his high school exams. BUT a teacher at his school recognized his talent and recommended that he study graphic art, and the rest is art history!
2. During his lifetime, Escher made 448 lithographs, woodcuts and wood engravings and over 2000 drawings and sketches. His most famous works are images that look convincing but defy logic. Some of them are 'Drawing Hands' (1948), in which two hands draw each other; 'Relativity' (1953), in which normal laws of gravity don't apply. She has several homes and storage spaces and art studios. She says that she doesn't like to live near her own art. So she is always moving.
3. After visiting castle in Spain called La Alhambra that was built in 1350, Escher was inspired by the art painted and tiled into the castle walls. The art used a form of mathematics known as tessellation.

## Facility Re-Opening Proposed Updates

As we continue with Remote Learning, the Taskforce meets weekly to further develop Gate City's hybrid model of education. We are currently operating in Level Orange as we monitor the local data presented by the Department of Health and Human Services in the State of NH. While our target start date of January 19th for hybrid education is GCCS's goal, it is imperative to understand that GCCS continues to monitor its criteria to ensure a safe re-opening of the school building.

LEVEL	MODALITY	TARGET % in Building
RED	Remote Learning & No staff in the building	0%
ORANGE	Only staff allowed use of the building	10%
YELLOW	Primarily Remote Learning, 1 day a week in-person learning (ALL GRADES)	60%
GREEN	2 days per week in-person learning (ALL GRADES)	85%
BLUE	Near normal operations	99%

### CRITERIA TO CONSIDER IN ORDER OF PRIORITY

\*Board and taskforce recommendations and decisions take precedence

SOURCES	TYPES OF DATA
GOVERNMENT DECREES	Federal, Governor, or DHHS decrees
LOCAL DATA	County COVID positivity rate, case counts, level of community transmission etc.
RESOURCE AVAILABILITY	Staffing availability (including hiring of School Nurse), bus/ after school program availability,
FACILITY READINESS	Purchase and installation of Personal Protective Equipment, protective barrier equipment, and disinfectant/ cleaning supplies

Tessellation is a pattern of shapes that fit together without any gaps.

4. Like great artists Da Vinci and Michelangelo, M.C. Escher was also *left handed*.
5. Many fantasy scenes and locations in Hollywood movies were inspired by Escher paintings like Relativity.
